

POST-DEGREE PROGRAM IN HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

Seneca College in Toronto offers a program in Human Resources Management for students who have completed a university degree but feel they require specialized training for the job market.

The program consists of two semesters of course work and the opportunity for selected students to complete an additional semester of co-op work experience. In other words, the program is two semesters for non-co-op students and 3 semesters for co-op students.

Completion of the Seneca program also prepares students to write the qualifying exams for CHRP (Certified Human Resource Professional) – a widely recognized designation and a requirement for many HR job openings.

The Seneca program boasts small class sizes, qualified faculty who are seasoned HR professionals and a curriculum that is both applied and academically challenging.
